## Spotlight on: My Brother's Keeper

For over 8 years, the kind people of My Brother's Keeper (IHMCC, Los Alamos Chapter), have been faithfully bringing handmade sleeping bags for the homeless who use our services.

My Brother's Keeper's goal is to make simple sleeping bags from recycled fabrics and distribute them free to people who are cold and on the streets. The effort that is put into these sleeping bags helps to provide warmth and protection from the cold.

The sleeping bags are made from many types of materials including old/ damaged blankets or quilts, sheets, double knit polyester, draperies, denim and many other heavy materials. All materials

used are recycled. The finished sleeping bag does not look brand new but it is functional and warm. It's all that separates and protects the homeless from the cold New Mexico nights.

My Brother's Keeper has many chapters across the United States. The Los Alamos group was started over 20 years ago by Eunice Larson. In this past year, about 3-7 members per week have made between 80-90 sleeping bags for distribution to the homeless.

We thank everyone at My Brother's Keeper who has worked so hard on this project, These bags are truly works of love and are very much appreciated by our clients.
