#### Happy holidays to all!

What a year! Cautiously going in to 2022, we still felt the sense of responsibility to our clients to offer more services in order to help them restart their lives as Covid restrictions were lifted.

As mentioned in our Spring/Summer newsletter, we started a test-run of our Pet Pantry program. We are pleased to announce that due to its success, we will be keeping the program as part of our regular on-going services. We are now discussing whether to include other pet species (rabbits, reptiles, hamsters, fish) and will be checking with our clients whether this is of interest to them or not. Thank you to those who have donated specifically to this program. If you would like all or part of your contribution to go to the program, please specify this on your return envelope enclosed in this letter.

In July, in our new partnership with DoorDash, we began our home deliverv service for those who are unable to come to our pantry to pick up food. We deliver to those clients who either lack reliable transportation to our pantry or who have a disability that makes it unsafe or impossible to travel outside of their homes. We still have room to add more clients to this service and feel we will be using the service at

100% capacity by March 2023. To achieve this, we need a couple of dedicated volunteers to assist us on Thursday mornings, the day the deliveries go out each week. We are looking for 2 people who would oversee putting the boxes together for clients. Each client receives 2 packages of food, each weighing approximately 25 pounds. Help is needed between 9:00am-11:00am. If you can help, even if it is only once or twice a month, please call Clarissa. She'd love to have you on the team!

The holiday season also means we are very busy getting ready to receive the gifts for our children that our generous donors provide and giving out Food King food vouchers to our clients so that they may have a wonderful holiday meal with their families and friends. This is the time of year we all give thanks to what we have in our lives and also give thanks that we can help others. Isn't that what the holiday season is all about?
